



Cleeve Cricket Club is committed to keeping children and young people safe from harm.

**Best practice is that adults and children and young people under the age of 18 do not use changing facilities at the same time.**

At Cleeve it is not always possible to ensure this. We follow the following guidelines:

1. Adults should always try to change at separate times to children during matches i.e. when padding up
2. When there is no alternative and Adults and children need to share a changing facility, the Club must have consent from the Parents that their child(ren) can share a changing room with Adults in the club
3. If children play for Adult Teams, they and their Parents must be informed of the Club's policy on changing arrangements
4. Mixed gender teams must have access to separate male and female changing rooms
5. Mobile phones must not be used in changing rooms

If children are uncomfortable changing or showering at the Club, no pressure should be placed on them to do so.

Encourage them to do this at home.
