

Cleeve Cricket Club Transport Policy



Cleeve Cricket Club play matches at the home ground and at other clubs and venues in the local area.

As part of our commitment to safeguarding children the following policy applies when the fixtures take place away from the home ground.

Parents / Carers are responsible for taking their children to away games and are also responsible for the welfare of their child whilst on the away team's premises.

If the child is transported by another parent/guardian/manager or volunteer they will be responsible for the welfare of that child for that particular away match.

Drivers are not allowed to be alone with a child, except their own.

Players emergency contact numbers and medical notes etc **must** be carried by managers to all away matches.

Managers need to be aware who each player is travelling with.

The manager will provide parents / carers with a contact telephone number.

Drivers will need to show the manager their driving license at the start of the season.

All vehicles transporting children must be in a roadworthy condition and must be taxed, have a valid MOT and insurance.

Children must be transported in seats which have three point seat belts (not lap belts).
